Most people who live in rural area in northern region of Thailand still lack of opportunity to receive a good health service. These people every year face seasonal disease and epidemic. And due to their resident location which is far from hospital and their poverty problem, they usually treat the illness by themselves. However, without a thorough understanding of the illness, a lot of patient suffer worse and that has caused them to be transferred to the Suandok hospital in the city, which usually is too late to cure. One way to solve this problem is that the local must be provided with understanding of the fundamental knowledge of ways to treat the first-phase symptom.

The Mobile Hospital project aims to raise fund and donation for big size coaches which it can be modified to a small clinic for health and dental services. Also the standard medical and dental equipments will be installed to the mobile hospital in order to provide a standard health service to the people living belong the border and non-identifed people. Morever, this mobile hospital coach will be used in case of natural disaster or large accident

Suandok Hospotial Foundation of Chiang Mai University will be responding for maintenance of the coach and other expense when going out to communities. Moreover, as a part of strategic partner, the foundation will also provide doctors, dentists and other staffs to the project and will cooperate with local Rotary Club to serve the community. This project will also help promoting Rotary and Suandok Hospital Foundation together at the same time
