B. AG/Regional Chair

- AG/Regional Chair with the greatest number of increase of members and also percentage
- The hard working AG/Regional Chair in membership drive

C. Individual

- Rotarians who bring more than 3 members for RY 2011-12

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL AWARDS FOR 2011 /2012

1) RI Service Above Self Award

Nominators: District governors, immediate past district governors, RI directors, past RI directors

Deadline: 1 September

As Rotary's highest honor for individual Rotarians, this award recognizes up to 150 Rotarians annually who have demonstrated exemplary humanitarian service, with an emphasis on personal volunteer efforts and active involvement in helping others through Rotary. Current district governors, directors, and past directors may nominate up to three candidates by

Deadline: 1 September each year.

2) Avenues of Service Citation

Nominators: Club presidents

Deadline: Ongoing

This citation program provides a way for Rotary clubs to personally recognize one club member for his or her outstanding efforts in the five Avenues of Service. A club member must have demonstrated support of the Object of Rotary through active participation in each of the five Avenues of Service: Club, Vocational, Community, International, and New Generations. Nominees must be an active Rotarian and can only receive the award once.

3) RI Vocational Service Leadership Award

Nominators: District governors Deadline: 30 December

This award recognizes Rotarians who have made a significant impact on advancing vocational service. District governors may nominate one candidate from their district each year.

4) The Rotary Foundation Citation for Meritorious Service (for Rotarians)

One Rotarian from each district may be recognized by the Trustees during the year for outstanding service to the Foundation extending beyond one year. Nominations are solicited



from governors and RI directors. Because the Trustees consider these nominations throughout the year, there is no single deadline; however, nominations should

be submitted at least eight weeks ahead of the planned presentation date and no later than 15 May.

Deadline: Ongoing until 15 May

5) The Rotary Foundation District Service Award

Nominators: District governors

Deadline: Ongoing

Because so many Rotarians serve humanity through Foundation programs, The Rotary Foundation created the District Service Award to recognize their efforts. Each recipient is given a certificate, awarded at the district level.

6) Service Award for a Polio-Free World

Nominators: Any Rotarian Deadline: 1 November

This award was established by the Trustees of the Rotary Foundation in order to recognize outstanding contributions to the effort by Rotarians and thereby to encourage final efforts. In geographic areas coinciding with WHO regions, up to ten regional service awards per region are given annually. These awards recognize outstanding service in polio eradication. International Awards, for broad service to the cause of polio eradication, are also made annually, not to exceed ten individuals.
