

DISTRICT 3310 GOVERNOR HAJI ZAINIE'S TRIP TO INDIA......IN PROMOTING WORLD UNDERSTANDING AND PEACE

The Rotary International District Governor District 3310, Haji Zainie Abdul Aucasa led a delegation of senior Rotary Club leaders from Rotary Club of Bandar Seri Begawan (3 Rotarians & 2 RotaryAnns) and Rotary Club of Likas Bay (1 Rotarian & RotaryAnn) together with the District First Lady Hajjah Kalimah to Kolkata, India- The City of Joy from 16th to 20th June, 2012.

The main purpose of the trip to Kolkata was not only to reciprocate the visit by RI Director Shekhar Mehta and his spouse Rashi to Brunei Darulsalam in December and to Kota Kinabalu in May this year in building good friendship and relationship with Rotarians in India, thus enhancing world understanding and peace but most importantly to explore the possibility of collaborating for medical expertise between RI District 3291 and our District 3310 for humanitarian projects such as the heart surgery project and prevention of Avoidable Blindness Outreach (ABO) programme.

The "Save Little Hearts" Project

The Rotary Club of Calcutta Mahanagar has offered our district 15 free surgeries every year under their "Save Little Hearts" programme which is a heart surgery project for children with congenital heart disease. So our mission has not been in vain, happily remarked by DG Hj. Zainie

The "Save Little Hearts" project is one of the major humanitarian programs funded by Rotary India Humanity Foundation (RIHF) and Rotary Clubs in India to help those children who are below the poverty line and cannot afford of this expensive surgery. More than 500 surgeries have been successfully performed and RIHF aims to do 2,000 surgeries per year, said the RI Director Shekhar Mehtar.

Prevention of Avoidable Blindness Outreach (ABO)

The Rotary Beleghata Eye Hospital under the purview of Rotary India Humanity Foundation (RIHF) is a very well established eye hospital with excellent facilities and there have save thousands of eyesight in Kolkata over the years. It is glad that the Rotary Beleghata Eye Hospital is willing to collaborate with Rotary Clubs in our district for future ABO projects, exclaimed by DG Haji Zainie

The Project Green Magicis

Another important agenda for the trip to Kolkata is to visit the Rotary Club of Calcutta Mega City, District 3291 which is the partner of Rotary Club of Bandar Seri Begawan for the Project Green Magicis, planting of 145,000 fruit trees in the province of Bengal under the Rotary Foundation Matching Grant funding. As part of the program, Project Green Magicis initiated by Rotary Clubs in India aims at planting one million fruit trees over the next few years, the fruit tree's planting will not only able to combat the adverse effects of global warming but help to create livelihoods for rural communities in India, thereby empowering them to financial independent.

To mark the launching of Matching Grant project between Rotary Club of Calcutta Mega City and Rotary Club of Bandar Seri Begawan, a symbolic planting of fruit trees was carried out together with the Rotary International Director Shekhar Mehta and several senior Rotarians from Kolkata at the Park Circus Maidian.

These are very meaningful long term humanitarian projects and Rotarians of the world had amply demonstrated Rotary's Motto: "Service Above Self" and focused on the six area of focus, namely Peace and Conflict prevention/resolution, disease prevention and treatment, water and sanitation, maternal and child health, basic education and literacy and economic and community development in doing good to the world. Rotary Clubs in our district 3310 will endeavour to organise the heart surgery project and Avoidable Blindness Outreach (ABO) in collaboration with the Rotary Clubs in India.
